

Holiday at Home Dog friendly holidays Yorkshire

Dogs are welcome in most of our Holiday at Home properties:

At **Brompton Lakes** dogs are welcome in 15 of our 20 lodges and the other 5 lodges are kept dog free. You can check on the site plan to see which ones are suitable. As well as the 26 acres of private grounds, which include lakeside and riverside paths, each lodge has plenty of space around it and the large outdoor decking area is perfect for canine guests to take alfresco meals or enjoy a bit of sunbathing.

Dogs are welcome in all three houses at **Holly House Farm**. As well as the private grounds of approximately 1 acre, each house has a gated patio garden perfect for canine guests. Please bear in mind the gates are not very high so more athletic dogs will be able to escape fairly easily.

All breeds of dogs are welcome at **30 Frenchgate**. The garden has high walls and is gated so most dogs would find it difficult to escape. There are plenty of scenic places to walk nearby.

New York Public Library and **Greenbank Barns** are also dog friendly and are set amidst acres of rural countryside for you and your dog to explore.

Woodcroft Cottage welcomes 2 small dogs also, there is an enclosed garden and plenty of walks around the Yorkshire Dales nearby.

Booking in your dog

Please specify at the time of booking if you intend to bring your dog(s). An extra charge of £6.00 per dog per night (up to a maximum of two dogs) is applicable. Registered guide and hearing dogs belonging to those with visual and hearing impairments stay without charge.

Prohibited Breeds

In the interest of guest safety – especially children – and the welfare of other guests dogs, the following breeds of dogs are not allowed at Brompton Lakes and Holly House Farm. We regret any inconvenience this may cause.

All dog breeds are allowed at 30 Frenchgate, New York Public Library, Greenbank Barns and Woodcroft Cottage as these properties all have enclosed private garden areas.

Breeds classified under the Dangerous Dogs Act

- Pit Bull Terriers
- Japanese Tosa
- Dogo Argentino
- Fila Brasileiro

Other prohibited breeds

- Rottweilers
- Staffordshire Bull Terriers
- Chow Chows
- Alaskan Malamutes
- Bull Mastiffs
- English Bull Terriers
- Japanese Akitas

Canine code of conduct

In our experience, it's rare to find luxury accommodation that accepts dogs but we believe the two needn't be mutually exclusive! However, for your pet's safety and the consideration of other guests, we do ask that dogs and their owners follow a few simple rules while they are staying.

- Dogs must be properly controlled and supervised at all times.
- Dogs must not be left unattended in the houses.
- In order to keep the houses in top condition for all of our guests, dogs are not permitted in the bedrooms or on any of the furniture and we therefore advise owners to bring a pet basket.
- Guests are asked to clean up after dogs both inside and outside of the property or extra cleaning costs may be charged. Special bins are available for the disposal of dog waste.

Dog sitting service

Pet Pals is a local dog walking and sitting service. So if you are popping out for the evening and require a dog sitter, or are out for the day and need your dog walking, then a fully trained member of the Pet Pals team should be able to assist you.
